When you ride the Dog Mountain shuttle, your car stays behind, and you're free to enjoy not only the hike up the mountain but also a beautiful ride through the Gorge.

GETTING TO CASCADE LOCKS

Columbia Gorge Express bus. Use Google Maps transit or refer to ColumbiaGorgeExpress.com for the schedule. 3 bike rack spots, first come, first served.

BIKING OR WALKING FROM CASCADE LOCKS TO SHUTTLE

4 miles one-way. Walk with your bike across the Bridge of Gods for \$1, cross Hwy 14 with extreme caution and enjoy a leisurely ride or stroll to the Dog Mountain Shuttle stop, where you can lock up before hopping on.

Dogs are welcome at the Best Western Plus Hotel and on the Dog Mountain Shuttle

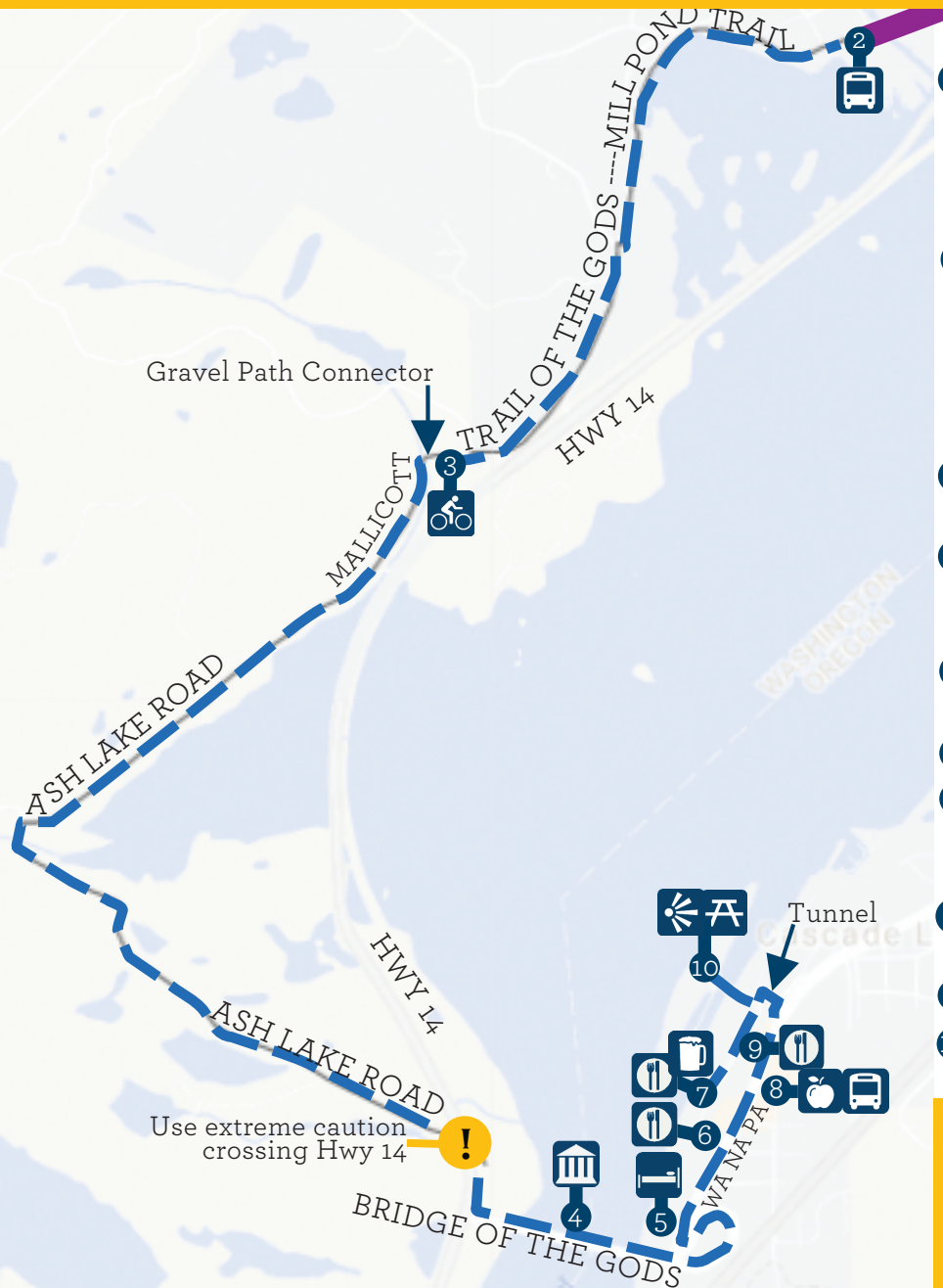

ITINERARY HIGHLIGHTS

-  **DOG MOUNTAIN HIKE**- 6 mile roundtrip hike. \$1.50 hiking permit reservation required in advance at recreation.gov on Saturdays and Sundays (unless you ride the shuttle) plus \$5 parking fee. Parking lot is persistently full so we recommend the shuttle!
-  **DOG MOUNTAIN SHUTTLE** - \$2 (exact cash) roundtrip includes Dog Mountain hiking permit, kids under 12 free. April 20-June 16, Saturday/Sunday. First departure from fairgrounds at 7:30 am, last departure from Dog Mtn at 5 pm; running every 30-40 minutes. 15 minute ride each way. From Cascade Locks, you can walk, bike or drive your car to Skamania Fairgrounds.
-  **TRAIL OF THE GODS / MILL POND TRAIL** - 1 mile car-free walking and biking trail.
-  **BRIDGE OF THE GODS** - Walk or walk your bike across (\$1 toll goes away June 1). Dogs are allowed, but use caution with metal grating.
-  **BEST WESTERN PLUS** - dog friendly hotel boasting rooms with river views and an indoor pool.
-  **BRIGHAM FISH MARKET** - Fried seafood and salmon chowder.
-  **THUNDER ISLAND BREWING CO** - Community hub that hosts craft beer made on the spot, great food (gluten-free/veg options) and a fantastic patio with stellar views.
-  **COLUMBIA MARKET** - Local grocer for picnic provisions and personal needs. Location of Columbia Gorge Express stop.
-  **EAST-WIND DRIVE-IN** - Epic soft serve! Diner fare.
-  **THUNDER ISLAND** - This little island is a great destination for a walk or picnic.
